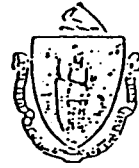

IN THE YEAR ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT ~~AMENDING SECTION 1 OF CHAPTER 68 OF THE
GENERAL LAWS PERTAINING TO A DIRECTOR OF THE CHRISTIAN
SCIENCE CHURCH OF BOSTON~~

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the
authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Chapter 68 of the General Laws is
hereby amended by inserting at the end of said section the
following sentence: "For purposes of this chapter members
of The Christian Science Board of Directors of The First
Church of Christ, Scientist, in Boston, Massachusetts,
shall, notwithstanding any other provision of law, be deemed
to be citizens of the Commonwealth if they are residents
thereof."
