## Epilogue for Our Glorious Heritage

In the end, we must establish our house in heaven. What better source from which to draw than the fountain of living waters provided for us in the writings of Mary Baker Eddy? In the words of Mrs. Eddy:

"No person can take the individual place of the Virgin Mary. No person can compass or fulfil the individual mission of Jesus of Nazareth. If you maintain this position, who or what can cause you to sin or suffer? Our surety is in our confidence that we are indeed dwellers in Truth and Love, man's eternal mansion. Such a heavenly assurance ends all warfare, and bids tumult cease, for the good fight we have waged is over, and divine Love gives us the true sense of victory.
