- c. every other idea cannot truly reject, refuse, fail to accept, nurture, cherish the new idea, plan, purpose Being is bringing to it; is not warring against the idea or failing to take it on.
- d. every other idea is not rejecting, refusing, failing to accept, nurture, cherish the new idea, plan, purpose Being is bringing to the universe of being; is not warring against the idea, preventing or making sure another cannot take it on, including that which appears as me.
