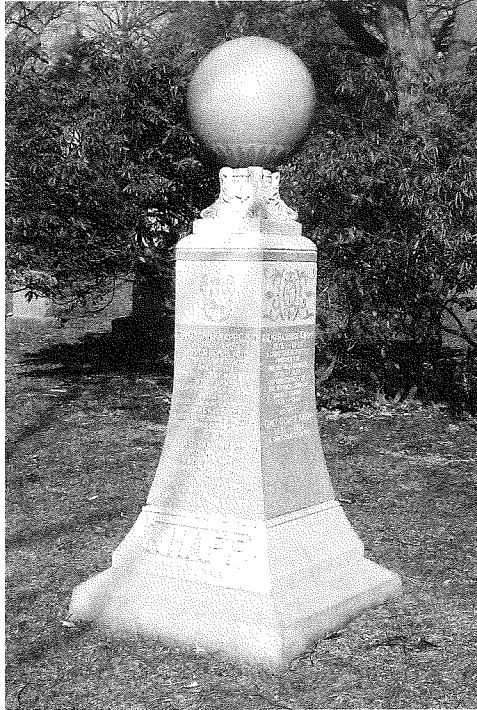


Appendix II



IRA O. KNAPP FAMILY MONUMENT

The Ira O. Knapp family monument is located in Mt. Auburn Cemetery in Cambridge, Massachusetts, Grapevine Path, Lot 5368. Ira, Flavia, their four children and their spouses are all remembered on the monument. Mary Baker Eddy's monument is located in the same cemetery.
