John 14:20

20 At that day ye shall know that I am in my Father, and ye in me, and I in you.

Responsive Reading

Jonah 3:4-10

4 And Jonah began to enter into the city a day's journey, and he cried, and said, Yet forty days, and Nineveh shall be overthrown.

5 #So the people of Nineveh believed God, and proclaimed a fast, and put on sackcloth, from the greatest of them even to the least of them.

6 For word came unto the king of Nineveh, and he arose from his throne, and he laid his robe from him, and covered him with sackcloth, and sat in ashes.

5 So Jonah went out of the city, and sat on the east side of the city, and there made him a booth, and sat under it in the shadow, till he might see what would become of the city.

6 And the Lord God prepared a gourd, and made it to come up over Jonah, that it might be a shadow over his head, to deliver him from his grief. So Jonah was exceeding glad of the gourd.

7 But God prepared a worm when the morning rose the next day, and it smote the gourd that it withered.

11 Teach me thy way, O Lord; I will walk in thy truth: unite my heart to fear thy name.

6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

3000 Chapter 2: Atonement and Eucharist - 18:1

(Divine oneness)

Atonement is the exemplification of man's unity with God, whereby man reflects divine Truth, Life, and Love. Jesus of Nazareth taught and demonstrated man's oneness with the Father, and for this we owe him endless homage. His mission was both individual and collective. He did life's work aright not only in justice to himself, but in mercy to mortals, - to show them how to do theirs, but not to do it for them nor to relieve them of a single responsibility. Jesus acted boldly, against the accredited evidence of the senses, against Pharisaical creeds and practices, and he refuted all opponents with his healing power.

oloo Chapter 8: Footsteps of Truth - 202:3-14

(The uses of truth)

The scientific unity which exists between God walk, in the vanity of their mind, and man must be wrought out in life-practice, and God's will must be universally done.

(Divine study)

If men would bring to bear upon the study of the Science of Mind half the faith they bestow upon the so-called pains and pleasures of material sense, they would not go on from bad to worse, until disciplined by the prison and the scaffold; but the whole human family would be redeemed through the merits of Christ, - through which is corrupt according to the the perception and acceptance of Truth. For this glorious result Christian Science lights the torch of spiritual understanding.

oo3o Chapter 10: Science of Being - 269:9-11

(Divine metaphysics)

Human philosophy has made God manlike. Christian Science makes man Godlike. The first is error; the latter is truth.

4000 Chapter 1: Prayer - 12:10

(Prayer for the sick)

It is neither Science nor Truth which acts through blind belief, nor is it the human understanding of the divine healing Principle as manifested in Jesus, whose humble prayers were tenderhearted, forgiving one another, deep and conscientious protests of Truth, - of man's likeness to God and of man's unity with Truth and Love.

Section 2

Ephesians 4:17,18,22-25,31,32

17 This I say therefore, and testify in the Lord, that ye henceforth walk not as other Gentiles

18 Having the understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God through the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart:

22 That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, deceitful lusts;

23 And be renewed in the spirit of your mind;

24 And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness.

25 Wherefore putting away lying, speak every man truth with his neighbour: for we are members one of another.

31 Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger, and clamour, and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice:

32 And be ye kind one to another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.

3000 Chapter 2: Atonement and Eucharist - 23:4-20

(Justice and substitution) The atonement requires constant selfimmolation on the sinner's part. That God's wrath should be vented upon His beloved Son, is divinely unnatural. Such a theory is man-made. The atonement is a hard problem in theology, but its scientific explanation is, that suffering is an error of sinful sense which Truth destroys, and that eventually both sin and suffering will fall at the feet of everlasting Love.

(Doctrines and faith)

Rabbinical lore said: "He that taketh one doctrine, firm in faith, has the Holy Ghost dwelling in him." This preaching receives a strong rebuke in the Scripture, "Faith without works is dead." Faith, if it be mere belief, is as a pendulum swinging between nothing and something, having no fixity. Faith, advanced to spiritual understanding, is the evidence gained from Spirit, which rebukes sin of every kind and establishes the claims of God.

3000 Chapter 2: Atonement and Eucharist - 24:11

(Radical changes)

He to whom "the arm of the Lord" is revealed will believe our report, and rise into newness of life with regeneration. This is having part in the atonement; this is the understanding, in which Jesus suffered and triumphed. The time is not distant when the ordinary theological views of atonement will undergo a great change, - a change as radical as that which has come over popular opinions in regard to predestination and future punishment.

oloo Chapter 8: Footsteps of Truth - 241:31-3

(Spiritual baptism)

It is "easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle," than for sinful beliefs to enter the kingdom of heaven, eternal harmony. Through repentance, spiritual baptism, and regeneration,

immolation on the sinner's part. That God's wrathmortals put off their material beliefs and false should be vented upon His beloved Son, is individuality.

Section 3

James 1:17,18,22

17 Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning.

18 Of his own will begat he us with the word of truth, that we should be a kind of firstfruits of his creatures.

22 But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves.

James 2:14,18,26

14 What doth it profit, my brethren, though a man say he hath faith, and have not works? can faith save him?

18 Yea, a man may say, Thou hast faith, and I have works: shew me thy faith without thy works, and I will shew thee my faith by my works.

26 For as the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without works is dead also.

Revelation 22:14

14 Blessed are they that do his commandments, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may

3000 Chapter 2: Atonement and Eucharist -22:23

(Deliverance not vicarious)

Final deliverance from error, whereby we rejoice in immortality, boundless freedom, and sinless sense, is not reached through paths of to another's vicarious effort. Whosoever believeth that wrath is righteous or that divinity is appeased by human suffering, does not understand God.

3000 Chapter 2: Atonement and Eucharist -24:20-28

(Purpose of crucifixion)

Jesus chiefly as providing a ready pardon for all sinners who ask for it and are willing to be forgiven? Does spiritualism find Jesus' death necessary only for the presentation, after death, of the material Jesus, as a proof that spirits can return to earth? Then we must differ from them both.

The efficacy of the crucifixion lay in the practical affection and goodness it demonstrated for mankind.

3000 Chapter 2: Atonement and Eucharist - 25:6-16,22-26

(True flesh and blood)

The material blood of Jesus was no more efficacious to cleanse from sin when it was shed upon "the accursed tree," than when it was flowing in his veins as he went daily about his Father's business. His true flesh and blood were his Life; and they truly eat his flesh and drink his blood, who partake of that divine Life.

(Effective triumph)

Jesus taught the way of Life by demonstration, that we may understand how this divine Principle heals the sick, casts out error, and triumphs over death.

Though demonstrating his control over sin and disease, the great Teacher by no means relieved others from giving the requisite proofs of their own piety. He worked for their guidance, that flowers nor by pinning one's faith without works they might demonstrate this power as he did and understand its divine Principle.

Section 4

Ephesians 2:11-19

11 Wherefore remember, that ye Does erudite theology regard the crucifixion of being in time past Gentiles in the flesh, who are called Uncircumcision by that which is called the Circumcision in the flesh made by hands:

> 12 That at that time ye were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope, and without God in the world:

13 But now in Christ Jesus ye who sometimes were far off are made nigh by the blood of Christ.

14 For he is our peace, who hath made both one, and hath broken down the middle wall of partition between us;

15 Having abolished in his flesh the enmity, even the law of

commandments contained in ordinances; for to make in himself of twain one new man, so making peace;

16 And that he might reconcile both unto God in one body by the cross, having slain the enmity thereby:

17 And came and preached peace to you which were afar off, and to them that were nigh.

18 For through him we both have access by one Spirit unto the Father.

19 Now therefore ye are no more strangers and foreigners, but fellowcitizens with the saints, and of the household of God;

3000 Chapter 2: Atonement and Eucharist -18:13

(Human reconciliation)

The atonement of Christ reconciles man to God, not God to man; for the divine Principle of Christ is God, and how can God propitiate Himself? Christ is Truth, which reaches no higher than itself. The fountain can rise no higherstriving to enter in. He constantly turns away than its source. Christ, Truth, could conciliate no from material sense, and looks towards the nature above his own, derived from the eternal Love. It was therefore Christ's purpose to reconcile man to God, not God to man. Love and Truth are not at war with God's image and likeness. Man cannot exceed divine Love, and so atone for himself. Even Christ cannot reconcile Truth to error, for Truth and error are irreconcilable. Jesus aided in reconciling man to God by giving man a truer sense of Love, the divine Principle of Jesus' teachings, and this truerlifted up his eyes to heaven, and sense of Love redeems man from the law of matter, sin, and death by the law of Spirit, - the

law of divine Love.

3000 Chapter 2: Atonement and Eucharist -19:17-24

(Efficacious repentance)

Every pang of repentance and suffering, every effort for reform, every good thought and deed, will help us to understand Jesus' atonement for sin and aid its efficacy; but if the sinner continues to pray and repent, sin and be sorry, he has little part in the atonement, - in the at-onement with God, - for he lacks the practical repentance, which reforms the heart and enables man to do the will of wisdom.

3000 Chapter 2: Atonement and Eucharist - 21:1-12

(Moral victory)

If Truth is overcoming error in your daily walk and conversation, you can finally say, "I have fought a good fight . . . I have kept the faith," because you are a better man. This is having our part in the at-one-ment with Truth and Love. Christians do not continue to labor and pray, expecting because of another's goodness, suffering, and triumph, that they shall reach his harmony and reward.

If the disciple is advancing spiritually, he is imperishable things of Spirit.

Section 5

John 17:1,6,15,19-23

1 These words spake Jesus, and said, Father, the hour is come; glorify thy Son, that thy Son also

may glorify thee:

6 I have manifested thy name unto the men which thou gavest me out of the world: thine they were, and thou gavest them me; and they have kept thy word.

15 I pray not that thou shouldest take them out of the world, but that thou shouldest keep them from the evil.

19 And for their sakes I sanctify myself, that they also might be sanctified through the truth.

20 Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall believe on me through their word;

21 That they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me.

(-24- God the parent Mind) XXIV. God, the divine Principle of man, and

man in God's likeness are inseparable, harmonious, and eternal.

3000 Chapter 2: Atonement and Eucharist - 45:17

(The stone rolled away) Christ hath rolled away the stone from the door of human hope and faith, and through the revelation and demonstration of life in God, hath elevated them to possible at-one-ment with the spiritual idea of man and his divine Principle, Love.

0002 Chapter 15: Genesis - 502:24

(Ideas and identities)

The infinite has no beginning. This word beginning is employed to signify the only, - that is, the eternal verity and unity of God and man, including the universe. The creative Principle - Life, Truth, and Love - is God. The universe reflects God. There is but one creator and one creation. This creation consists of the unfolding of spiritual ideas and their identities, which are embraced in the infinite Mind and forever reflected. These ideas range from the infinitesimal to infinity, and the highest ideas are the sons and daughters of God.

(Exalted thought)

Through divine Science, Spirit, God, unites understanding to eternal harmony. The calm and exalted thought or spiritual apprehension is at peace. Thus the dawn of ideas goes on, forming each successive stage of progress.

(Spirit names and blesses) Spirit duly feeds and clothes every object, as it appears in the line of spiritual creation, thus tenderly expressing the fatherhood and motherhood of God.
