23 And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

I Corinthians 15:34-44,48-50

- 34 Awake to righteousness, and sin not; for some have not the knowledge of God: I speak this to your shame.
- 35 But some man will say, How are the dead raised up? and with what body do they come?
- 36 Thou fool, that which thou sowest is not quickened, except it die:
- 37 And that which thou sowest, thou sowest not that body that shall be, but bare grain, it may chance of wheat, or of some other grain:

1000 Chapter 4: Christian Science versus Spiritualism - 84:3-7,28

(Scientific foreseeing)

The ancient prophets gained their foresight from a spiritual, incorporeal standpoint, not by foreshadowing evil and mistaking fact for fiction, - predicting the future from a groundwork of corporeality and human belief. (Scientific foreknowing)

All we correctly know of Spirit comes from

God, divine Principle, and is learned through Christ and Christian Science. If this Science has been thoroughly learned and properly digested, we can know the truth more accurately than the astronomer can read the stars or calculate an eclipse. This Mind-reading is the opposite of clairvoyance. It is the illumination of the spiritual understanding which demonstrates the capacity of Soul, not of material sense. This Soul-sense comes to the human mind when the latter yields to the divine Mind.

o2oo Chapter 7: Physiology - 167:3-6

(Health from reliance on spirituality) If we rise no higher than blind faith, the Science of healing is not attained, and Soulexistence, in the place of sense-existence, is not comprehended.

oo4o Chapter 9: Creation - 265:31

(Decapitation of error)

The pains of sense are salutary, if they wrench Section 2 away false pleasurable beliefs and transplant the affections from sense to Soul, where the creations of God are good, "rejoicing the heart." Psalm 66:8,9 Such is the sword of Science, with which Truth decapitates error, materiality giving place to man's higher individuality and destiny.

(15) Question: What are body and Soul? ADAM = A so-called finite mind, producing other minds, thus making "gods many and lords many."

Topic: Are Sin, Disease, and Death Real?

(Reflection of Spirit)

Question. - What are body and Soul?

Answer. - Identity is the reflection of Spirit, the reflection in multifarious forms of the living

intelligence of man, which is individualized, but not in matter. Soul can never reflect anything inferior to Spirit.

(Spiritual foreshadowings)

The prophet of to-day beholds in the mental horizon the signs of these times, the reappearance of the Christianity which heals the sick and destroys error, and no other sign shall be given.

(- MORTAL MIND - Sickness)

(-30- Divine pardon) Does not God's pardon, destroying any one sin, prophesy and involve the final destruction of all sin?

8 O bless our God, ye people, and make the voice of his praise to be heard:

9 Which holdeth our soul in life, and suffereth not our feet to be moved.

Romans 8:12,13

12 Therefore, brethren, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live after the flesh.

(Sickness as discord)

The body does not include soul, but manifests mortality, a false sense of soul. The delusion that lose his individuality; but as material sensation, there is life in matter has no kinship with the Lifeor a soul in the body, blind mortals do lose sight supernal.

0003 Chapter 14: Recapitulation - 478:3

(15) Question: What are body and Soul? ADAM = A so-called finite mind, producing other minds, thus making "gods many and lords many."

Topic: Are Sin, Disease, and Death Real?

(A vacant domicile)

What evidence of Soul or of immortality have you within mortality? Even according to the

teachings of natural science, man has never beheld Spirit or Soul leaving a body or entering it. What basis is there for the theory of indwelling spirit, except the claim of mortal belief? What would be thought of the declaration that a house was inhabited, and by a certain class of persons, when no such persons were ever seen to go into the house or to come out of it, nor were they even visible through the windows? Who can see a soul in the body?

oo3o Chapter 10: Science of Being - 300:26-28

(The divine reflection) The theory that soul, spirit, intelligence, inhabits matter is taught by the schools. This theory is unscientific.

oo3o Chapter 10: Science of Being (PLATFORM) - 336:32-4

(- MORTAL MIND - That which neither exists in Science nor can be recognized by the spiritual sense)

(-25- Man reflects the perfect God)

XXV. God is individual and personal in a scientific sense, but not in any anthropomorphic sense. Therefore man, reflecting God, cannot of spiritual individuality.

oloo Chapter 8: Footsteps of Truth - 216:28

(Personal identity)

When you say, "Man's body is material," I say with Paul: Be "willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord." Give up your material belief of mind in matter, and have but one Mind, even God; for this Mind forms its own likeness. The loss of man's identity through the understanding which Science confers is impossible; and the notion of such a possibility is more absurd than to conclude that individual musical tones are lost in the origin of harmony.

Psalm 56:11,13

11 In God have I put my trust: I will not be afraid what man can do unto me

13 For thou hast delivered my soul from death: wilt not thou deliver my feet from falling, that I may walk before God in the light of the living?

Matthew 10:28

o2oo Chapter 7: Physiology - 196:11

(Sin destroyed through suffering)

"Fear him which is able to destroy both soul and body in hell," said Jesus. A careful study of this text shows that here the word soul means a false sense or material consciousness. The command was a warning to beware, not of Rome, Satan, nor of God, but of sin. Sickness, sin, and death are not concomitants of Life or Truth. No law supports them. They have no relation to God wherewith to establish their power. Sin makes its own hell, and goodness its own heaven.

oo1o Chapter 12: Christian Science Practice - 405:29

(Cumulative repentance)

The pains of sinful sense are less harmful than its pleasures. Belief in material suffering causes mortals to retreat from their error, to flee from body to Spirit, and to appeal to divine sources outside of themselves.

oo1o Chapter 12: Christian Science Practice - 390:4

(Ultimate harmony)

We cannot deny that Life is self-sustained, and we should never deny the everlasting harmony ofthings? If God be for us, who can be Soul, simply because, to the mortal senses, there against us? is seeming discord. It is our ignorance of God, the divine Principle, which produces apparent discord, and the right understanding of Him restores harmony. Truth will at length compel us all to exchange the pleasures and pains of sense for the joys of Soul.

o3oo Chapter 6: Science, Theology, Medicine -119:27

(The sun and Soul)

As astronomy reverses the human perception of the movement of the solar system, so Christian Science reverses the seeming relation of Soul and body and makes body tributary to Mind. Thus it is with man, who is but the humble servant of the restful Mind, though it seems otherwise to finite sense. But we shall never understand this while we admit that soul is in body or mind in matter, and that man is included in non-intelligence. Soul, or Spirit, is God, unchangeable and eternal; and man coexists with and reflects Soul, God, for man is God's image.

o3oo Chapter 6: Science, Theology, Medicine -122:29-3

(Ptolemaic and psychical error)

Our theories make the same mistake regarding therefore glorify God in your body, Soul and body that Ptolemy made regarding the and in your spirit, which are God's. solar system. They insist that soul is in body and I Corinthians 12:12,13 mind therefore tributary to matter. Astronomical science has destroyed the false theory as to the relations of the celestial bodies, and Christian Science will surely destroy the greater error as to that one body, being many, are one our terrestrial bodies.

oo4o Chapter 9: Creation - 257:6

(Matter is not substance)

The theory that Spirit is not the only substance drink into one Spirit. and creator is pantheistic heterodoxy, which ultimates in sickness, sin, and death; it is the belief in a bodily soul and a material mind, a soul governed by the body and a mind in matter. This belief is shallow pantheism.

oloo Chapter 8: Footsteps of Truth - 210:11

(Jesus' disregard of matter)

Knowing that Soul and its attributes were forever manifested through man, the Master healed the sick, gave sight to the blind, hearing to the deaf, feet to the lame, thus bringing to light the scientific action of the divine Mind on human minds and bodies and giving a better understanding of Soul and salvation. Jesus healed sickness and sin by one and the same metaphysical process.

Reflecting God's government, man is self-governed. When subordinate to the divine Spirit, man cannot be controlled by sin or

death, thus proving our material theories about laws of health to be valueless.

ooo3 Chapter 14: Recapitulation - 493:26-4

(22b) Question: ...and show how it is to be healed?

ADAM = The usurper of Spirit's creation, called self-creative matter.

Topic: God the Preserver of Man

(Mind destroys all ills)

If Jesus awakened Lazarus from the dream, illusion, of death, this proved that the Christ could improve on a false sense. Paul had a clear sense of the demands of Truth *** upon mortals physically and spiritually, when he Numbers 21:6-9 said: "Present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service." But he, who is begotten of the beliefs of the flesh and serves them, can never reach in this world the divine heights of our Lord. The time cometh when the spiritual origin of man, the divine Science which ushered Jesus into human presence, will be understood and demonstrated.

(Jesus as mediator)
