Topic: Man

(Celestial evidence) God is infinite, therefore ever present, and there is no other power nor presence. oo2o Chapter 11: Some Objections Answered - 357:9

(Two infinite creators absurd)

If mankind would relinquish the belief that God makes sickness, sin, and death, or makes man capable of suffering on account of this malevolent triad, the foundations of error would be sapped and error's destruction ensured; but if we theoretically endow mortals with the creativeness and authority of Deity, how dare we attempt to destroy what He hath made, or even to deny that God made man evil and made evil good?

oo2o Chapter 11: Some Objections Answered - 356:19-21

(Copartnership impossible) God is as incapable of producing sin, sickness, and death as He is of experiencing these errors.

oloo Chapter 8: Footsteps of Truth - 206:26

(Birth and death unreal)

Instead of God sending sickness and death, He destroys them, and brings to light immortality. Omnipotent and infinite Mind made all and includes all. This Mind does not make mistakes and subsequently correct them. God does not cause man to sin, to be sick, or to die.

ooo4 Chapter 13: Teaching Christian Science - 450:19

(Touchstone of Science)

The Christian Scientist has enlisted to lessen evil, disease, and death; and he will overcome them by understanding their nothingness and the allness of God, or good. Sickness to him is no less a temptation than is sin, and he heals them both by understanding God's power over them.

The Christian Scientist knows that they are errors of belief, which Truth can and will destroy.

Section 2

II Chronicles 33:1,2,12,13,15,16

1 Manasseh was twelve years old when he began to reign, and he reigned fifty and five years in Jerusalem:

- 2 But did that which was evil in the sight of the Lord, like unto the abominations of the heathen, whom the Lord had cast out before the children of Israel.
- 12 And when he was in affliction, he besought the Lord his God, and humbled himself greatly before the God of his fathers.

(Weakness of material theories)

Sin, sickness, and death do not prove man's entity or immortality. Discord can never establish the facts of harmony. Matter is not the vestibule of Spirit.

(Irreconcilable differences)

Jesus reasoned on this subject practically, and controlled sickness, sin, and death on the basis of his spirituality.

oo2o Chapter 11: Some Objections Answered - 348:14

(Elimination of sickness)

Are we irreverent towards sin, or imputing too much power to God, when we ascribe to Him almighty Life and Love? I deny His cooperation with evil, because I desire to have no faith in evil or in any power but God, good. Is it not well to

eliminate from so-called mortal mind that which, so long as it remains in mortal mind, will show itself in forms of sin, sickness, and death? Instead of tenaciously defending the supposed rights of disease, while complaining of the suffering disease brings, would it not be well to abandon the defence, especially when by so doing our own condition can be improved and that of other persons as well?

oo2o Chapter 11: Some Objections Answered - 355:3-13

(Practical arguments)

The charge of inconsistency in Christianly scientific methods of dealing with sin and disease is met by something practical, - namely, the proof of the utility of these methods; and proofs are better than mere verbal arguments or prayers which evince no spiritual power to heal.

As for sin and disease, Christian Science says, in the language of the Master, "Follow me; and let the dead bury their dead." Let discord of every name and nature be heard no more, and let the harmonious and true sense of Life and being take possession of human consciousness.

PROPHET. A spiritual seer; disappearance of material sense before the conscious facts of spiritual Truth.

o3oo Chapter 6: Science, Theology, Medicine - 139:4-8

(Marvels and reformations)

From beginning to end, the Scriptures are full of accounts of the triumph of Spirit, Mind, over matter. Moses proved the power of Mind by what men called miracles; so did Joshua, Elijah, and Elisha.

584:15 Chapter 17: Glossary (DEATH)

Any material evidence of death is false, for it contradicts the spiritual facts of being.

427:1

(Life not contingent on matter)

If it is true that man lives, this fact can never change in Science to the opposite belief that man dies. Life is the law of Soul, even the law of the spirit of Truth, and Soul is never without its representative. Man's individual being can no more die nor disappear in unconsciousness than can Soul, for both are immortal. If man believes in death now, he must disbelieve in it when learning that there is no reality in death, since the truth of being is deathless. The belief that existence is contingent on matter must be met and mastered by Science, before Life can be understood and harmony obtained.

Mark 16:9,14-18

9 #Now when Jesus was risen early the first day of the week, he appeared first to Mary Magdalene, out of whom he had cast seven devils.

14 #Afterward he appeared unto the eleven as they sat at meat, and upbraided them with their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they believed not them which had seen him after he was risen.

(Final destruction of error)

Understanding little about the divine Principle which saves and heals, mortals get rid of sin, sickness, and death only in belief. These errors are not thus really destroyed, and must therefore cling to mortals until, here or hereafter, they gain the true understanding of God in the Science which destroys human delusions about Him and reveals the grand realities of His allness.

(Promise perpetual)

Understanding spiritual law and knowing that certain disciple named Tabitha, which there is no material law, Jesus said: "These signs by interpretation is called Dorcas: shall follow them that believe, . . . they shall take this woman was full of good works and up serpents, and if they drink any deadly thing, it almsdeeds which she did. shall not hurt them. They shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover." It were well had Christendom believed and obeyed this sacred saying.

Jesus' promise is perpetual. Had it been given her in an upper chamber. only to his immediate disciples, the Scriptural passage would read you, not they. The purpose of his great life - work extends through time and to Joppa, and the disciples had heard includes universal humanity. Its Principle is infinite, reaching beyond the pale of a single period or of a limited following. As time moves on, the healing elements of pure Christianity will be fairly dealt with; they will be sought and taught, and will glow in all the grandeur of universal goodness.

3000 Chapter 2: Atonement and Eucharist -

52:19

(Saviour's prediction)

The "man of sorrows" best understood the nothingness of material life and intelligence and the mighty actuality of all-inclusive God, good. These were the two cardinal points of Mindhealing, or Christian Science, which armed him with Love. The highest earthly representative of God, speaking of human ability to reflect divine power, prophetically said to his disciples, speaking not for their day only but for all time: "He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also;" and "These signs shall follow them that believe."

37 And it came to pass in those days, that she was sick, and died: whom when they had washed, they laid

38 And forasmuch as Lydda was nigh that Peter was there, they sent unto him two men, desiring him that he would not delay to come to them.

Topic: Mind

(Eternity of Life) Death and finiteness are would also have an ending.

(True sense of infinitude)

We bury the sense of infinitude, when we admit that, although God is infinite, evil has a place in this infinity, for evil can have no place, where all space is filled with God.

oolo Chapter 12: Christian Science Practice -386:16-2

(Erroneous despatch)

the death of a friend, occasions the same grief that the friend's real death would bring. You think that your anguish is occasioned by your loss. Another despatch, correcting the mistake, heals your grief, and you learn that your suffering was merely the result of your belief. Thus it is with all sorrow, sickness, and death. You will learn at length that there is no cause for grief, and divine wisdom will then be understood. Error, not Truth, produces all the suffering on earth.

(Mourning causeless)

If a Christian Scientist had said, while you were laboring under the influence of the belief of grief, "Your sorrow is without cause," you would not have understood him, although the correctness of the assertion might afterwards be proved to you. So, when our friends pass from our sight and we lament, that lamentation is needless and causeless. We shall perceive this to be true when we grow into the understanding of Life, and know that there is no death.

oo1o Chapter 12: Christian Science Practice -427:26

(No death nor inaction)

Called to the bed of death, what material remedy has man when all such remedies have failed? Spirit is his last resort, but it should have unknown to Life. If Life ever had a beginning, it been his first and only resort. The dream of death must be mastered by Mind here or hereafter. Thought will waken from its own material declaration, "I am dead," to catch this trumpetword of Truth, "There is no death, no inaction, diseased action, overaction, nor reaction."

XXVIII. Subject sickness, sin, and death to the rule of health and holiness in Christian Science, and you ascertain that this Science is demonstrably true, for it heals the sick and sinning as no other system can. Christian Science, rightly understood, leads to eternal harmony.

(-32- Basis of health and immortality)

The basis of all health, sinlessness, and immortality is the great fact that God is the only Mind; and this Mind must be not merely believed, but it must be understood. To get rid of sin through Science, is to divest sin of any supposed mind or reality, and never to admit that sin can have intelligence or power, pain or pleasure.
